Title: Two Day special camp for Budhgaon village (11th March to 13th March 2026)

Objective:

The objective of this environmental awareness program is to create awareness among students and local citizens about the importance of environmental protection and sustainable development. The program aims to promote cleanliness and proper waste management practices through activities like visits to waste collection centers. It also focuses on encouraging tree plantation to enhance green cover and maintain ecological balance. Another key objective is to spread awareness about the harmful effects of plastic pollution and to support the implementation of a plastic ban. Through various field visits, the program seeks to educate participants about local environmental resources and the need for their conservation. It also aims to develop a sense of social responsibility and community participation among students through NSS activities. Additionally, the program supports broader climate initiatives such as Maharashtra Youth for Climate Action and promotes sustainable lifestyle practices for long-term environmental protection. Overall, it strives to strengthen collaboration between educational institutions and local governing bodies while inspiring positive behavioral change towards an eco-friendly way of life.

Overall Report:
